Scope of Sandy's devastation widens

(Reuters) - Four days after superstorm Sandy smashed into the U.S. Northeast, rescuers on Friday were still discovering the extent of the death and devastation in New York and the New Jersey shore, and anger mounted over gasoline shortages, power outages and waits for relief supplies.

The total killed in one of the biggest storms to hit the United States jumped by a third on Thursday, to 98...

The financial cost of the storm promised to be staggering. Disaster modeling company Eqecat estimated Sandy caused up to \$20 billion in insured losses and \$50 billion in economic losses, double its previous forecast.

Wintry storm brings new misery to Northeast

(Reuters) - A wintry storm dropped heavy rain and snow on the Northeast on Wednesday, bringing dangerous winds and knocking out power in a region where hundreds of thousands were still in the dark after Superstorm Sandy.

The nor'easter storm meant fresh misery for thousands of people whose homes were destroyed by Sandy, which killed 79 people in the New York-New Jersey area alone when it smashed ashore on October 29, swallowing entire neighborhoods with rising seawater and blowing homes from their foundations.

Some 13,000 homes and businesses from the Carolinas to New York lost power on Wednesday, adding to the 650,000 customers who still lacked electricity from one of the biggest and costliest storms ever to hit the United States...

Cold and snow was particularly bad news to residents who lost heat. "It's coming up on 10 days with people being freezing in their homes," said Peter DiPaoloa, town supervisor of Pelham, located north of New York City.

"I lost all my winter clothing in the flood, so I am wearing three layers of things in order to stay somewhat warm and dry," said Wayne Steinman, a resident of Staten Island, one of the parts of New York City hardest hit by Sandy. "Everything becomes overwhelming."
